Many of you kept each other's children, so that business could be taken care of. Our Parent School Organization developed a "Swap List" to provide assistance to those in need. Even our children became involved! The boys and girls created "Thinking of You" cards in hopes of brightening one's day. Our middle school scholars helped Braes Interfaith Ministries unload an 18' truck of supplies for hurricane victims.
